



Fife Council Environmental Health Attendance

If you are required by the local authority to have a mobile sink (those handling high-risk foods/catered) then you must provide your own sink. It is also advisable for all other traders to have hand washing facilities at their stall. Please note that Food Safety Officers may be inspecting you on the day and Bowhouse staff will carry out random health and safety checks on a selection of random stalls so be prepared. Please also make sure you have all appropriate paperwork with you. We will also be doing our own health and safety checks on stalls selected at random

Here is a list of what they will be looking for:

- Has your lighting/refrigeration, cooking equipment, cabling and any other electrical equipment been inspected by a suitable qualified person in the last 12 months and meet IEE Regulations (Pat testing) and appropriate labels attached to the equipment?
- Business name address and contact details displayed on stall.
- Mobile sink (see above) and appropriate hand-wash materials – you must provide your own paper towels and soaps. Fife council EHO states that street food traders will need at least 3 sinks/washing vessels
- Risk assessment for your own produce and temperature control records.
- Labelling, display of goods within Environmental Food Guidelines.
- Public Liability Insurance certificate.
- Market Traders Licence and/or Food Hygiene Certificate (food and drink only).
- Personal license and/or signed record of 2-hour training certificate for any staff members selling alcohol (alcohol only).

If you do not have any of the above in place, officers will remove you from the market.
